Adversaries are pivoting from broad encryption to precision, Al-accelerated campaigns that blend deepfake persuasion, zero-day exploitation, and identity hijacking across hybrid cloud and OT estates. Defensive success in 2H 2025 hinges on 1. Identity-centric zero trust – assume MFA bypass & token theft by default 2. Operationalized patch velocity – shrink internet-exposed CVE windows to <72h 3. Resillent, tested backups – immutable, MFA-gated recovery is non-negotiable 4. Behavioral Al telemetry – instrument for anomalous LLM and agentic-Al usage
